CLASS DESCRIPTIONS AND
AUDITION LOGISTICS**

Classes Marked with an Asterisk* Require an Audition on the First Day of Camp

BIBLE

BIBLE ADVENTURES- Take an in-depth look at selected Scripture passages.

WORTHY OF WORSHIP- Study Who, What, When, Where, and Why we worship. And we will try and put it into practice.

CONDUCTING

YOU'RE THE CONDUCTOR- Learn how to conduct familiar hymns using the various beat patterns. Meets one period each day.

DRAMA

ACT LIKE SOMEONE ELSE- Learn basic drama skills including blocking and voice projection. Participate in some classroom games and dramas.

SIGNING 1- Begin learning the language of the hearing-impaired.

SIGNING 2*- Advanced learning the language of the hearing-impaired.

BUILDING IT UP!- Set design for the musical.

HANDBELLS

CHIME TIME- Open to all campers who want to learn to ring choir chimes.

INTRODUCTION TO BELLS- Students will learn handbell ringing techniques.

KEYBOARDS

ALL KEYED UP- Have you always wanted to play the piano? Get "all keyed up!" Piano playing: fun, and facts. Go home and share the songs you learn!

TUNING UP- For intermediate pianists with one or two years. Bring music you play well for continued coaching. We will be working on praise choruses and hymns.

MOVING UP *- Permission of instructor required. For experienced pianists with two or more years only. Bring music you play well for continued coaching. We will be working on praise choruses and hymns.

LARGE PERFORMING ENSEMBLES

CAMP BAND- Open to all campers and adults who play a band instrument. Plan to bring your own instrument. We will try to secure instruments typically provided by schools. The band will play several selections during the camp concert. Meets two periods each day.

CAMP CHOIR- Comprised of all children present at camp. The choir will sing during the camp concert. Meets three periods each day in Music Center.

MOVEMENT

CREATIVE MOVEMENT- Learn to use interpretive movement in the worship service. Solo and group performance principles for dramatic or musical presentations as either a solo performance or an accompaniment for live or recorded performances.

SMALLER INSTRUMENTAL ENSEMBLES

ROCKIN' RHYTHM - Learn all about rhythm and music while having fun playing games and instruments!

BEGINNING GUITAR- Learning to play guitar (bring your own guitar)

VOICE

BEGINNING VOICE- Principles of good vocal production, the changing voice, and elementary diction.
