29 years and look forward to some neat additions to camp this year. One of things I am most excited about for 2008 is the addition of an advanced class for future worship leaders. Youth selected by personal interview for this class will get to study the foundations of worship in one hour and prepare to help lead worship during our celebration service in the second hour. Another new class "Dealing with Difficult Social Issues" taught by Pastor John Keyes, will be offered to help interested students minister to their peers who are struggling with aids, homosexuality, abortion, and drugs.

In other camp news, due to an illness in her family, Jan Doughty, our camp director for many years will be unable to participate, however Jennifer Medford has stepped in to fill the position. Jennifer is the wife of Grant Medford, our IBSA Student and Family Ministry Director. Grant and Jennifer have traveled throughout the United States leading youth and drama seminars. We

welcome Jennifer as camp director for 2008. As usual, the campers will experience many expressions of music and worship including choir, band (for those who already play an instrument), Bible, drama, worship movement, piano, guitar (bring your own), and many other fun classes. Sign up early for best selection and see you in July!

Requirements

- Active in an IBSA Church or invited to attend with an IBSA church group
- Completed grades 7-12
- Interested in singing or playing an instrument

Cost

Camper/Sponsor cost:

- \$155 if pre-registered by June 22
- \$170 by July 4
- \$185 after July 4 (if space is available).

Staff registration cost:

- \$50 (Half due upon registration. Balance due upon arrival.)

Cost includes: room, board, music, texts, materials and accident insurance.

(The pre-registration fee is refundable if a written request is received by IBSA Worship and Church Music Ministries before June 22, 2008.)

Sponsors

- Each church is required to send one Sponsor for every five students.
- Sponsors should be at least 25 years of age
- Sponsors are expected to attend and participate in all classes and activities.
- IBSA asks the participating churches to pay the cost of the sponsors in order to

keep costs affordable for the campers.

- Staff members and faculty may **not** serve as sponsors.

All **Sponsors and Camp Staff** need to complete IBSA's *Camp Staff Application* and give IBSA permission to conduct background and reference checks. Applications must be completed and returned to IBSA before June 22.

Ensembles

If you play a band instrument, bring it and plan to play in the **CAMP BAND**. Persons who play orchestral **STRING** instruments, and **MALLET PERCUSSION** instruments (which we have, and pianists who read music well can play these without prior mallet experience) are especially needed, as are persons who play **CLARINET**, **OBOE**, and **BASSOON**! If requested in advance, instruments usually provided by schools will probably be available. All campers not in the All-State Youth Choir will sing in the **CAMP CHOIR**.

Facilities

All activities take place in an air-conditioned facilities. **Campers and adults must bring a \$10 bill for each room key as a deposit.** This amount will be refunded in full upon return of the key at the end of the camp.

Roommates can be requested, but not guaranteed.

(Linens are **not** provided by Greenville College. All campers should bring their own linens or sleeping bag and pillow.)

Class Information

A listing of faculty and class offerings for Youth Music Camp will be ready by April 28. and the Registration Form, class schedule, and class descriptions will be available after May 1. All campers must attend all chosen classes, rehearsals, worship services and special evening events. (Campers who meet the early registration deadline of June 22 will have maximum input into their class selection and schedule.)

Schedule

- Registration-Monday, 11:00-1:30
- Orientation-Monday, 2:45 p.m.
- Concert-**THURSDAY**, 7:00 p.m. (public invited)
- Tour Departure-**FRIDAY**, 10:00 a.m.
- Camp Departure-Most in camp choir will depart on Thursday night. If you need to leave on Friday morning, Greenville charges \$10 for the additional night stay.
