1. Successful examples
 - A. Leaders need to lead by example – we have to be prayed up.
2. Develop new models: teach the student the basics of prayer by
 - A. Prayer retreat
 - B. Concert of prayer
 - C. Pray through Scripture
3. Incorporate prayer in all aspects of youth ministry
 - A. Start and end every session with prayer
 - B. Ask the students for prayer requests
 - C. Develop a prayer wall
 - D. Recognize answered prayer
