



Trail Head Signage Project

Background

Lake Sallateeska has been a resource for Illinois Baptist Churches since 1942 for summer camps and retreats. Over the many years it has been open, the camp has seen children and adults come to Christ and deepen their relationship with Him. Through faithful service of volunteers and staff, the camp has been able to provide a place where people feel comfortable, safe and relaxed and a place where people can connect with the Lord and each other. One of the ways people enjoy our camp is through our extensive trail system. Trail signs would allow for easy access to information about the trails and the property.

Project

This project would consist of building 4 informational signs that will house a map of the trails and information about the area. The group will construct the signs, paint and help install them.



Logistics

This project would be great for a group of 3-6 adults and can be completed in one day. A group of well supervised youth could also participate in this project.

The camp will provide the building materials including wood, cement, paint, brushes and saws. The group will need to bring with them other tools such as hammers, drills, impacts and saws they might use.

Lodging is available at the camp for free. Snacks and drinks will be provided by the camp, but all meals will be the responsibility of the group. The camp can provide meals for \$7/meal/person if advance notice is given. There is also a kitchen available for groups that want to cook their own meals. Every project participant will receive a "Lake Sallateeksa Camp Volunteer" t-shirt and our gratitude for serving alongside us in ministry.
