



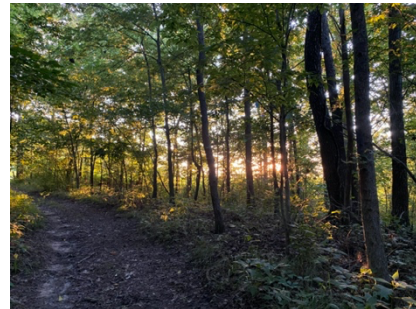
## Trail Mapping Project

### Background
