How will I access the class?

You will access your class entirely online through IBSA's web based online course service, Moodle. To see a short walkthrough of how a class is set up, [watch this video](#).

Do I have to attend class at certain days and times?

No. Edge courses are what is known as "asynchronous," meaning you, the other learners, and the instructor are not required to do learning activities at the same time. You will have reading, videos, or assignments to complete each week, but you decide when you will be online, do the reading, or complete work each week.

Will I have any live interaction with other learners or the instructor?

Yes! Most courses have several optional "live virtual classroom" offered during the duration of the course. These video classrooms occur during evening hours and allow live video interaction with the instructor and other learners in the class.

What if I cannot attend a "live virtual classroom" session because of my schedule?

That's okay. First, these are optional learning experiences. They are not required to be able to complete the course. Second, they are recorded and made available the next day for students who are unable to attend but would like to review the discussion and learn.
