Sidewalks - Observe

Front Yard - Orient

Method: Establish regular opportunities where your neighbors can cross your path. When invited, engage with neighbors in their front yard.

Questions to ask: When and where?

Goals: Discovering who your neighbors are and build relationships through conversations that build trust.

Dinner Table - Deepen

Method: Establish a regular pattern of engagement with your neighbors where you are seeking to engage those that God would put on your path.

Questions to ask: Why and how?

Goals: Identify the passions and pains of your neighbor to more effectively share the gospel.
