## The Deacon: His Character and Purpose (Teaching Outline)

## 1 Timothy 3:8-13

- 1. The Deacon's Report (8) "Deacons likewise must be dignified..."
  - The deacon should be worthy of respect or dignified.
  - This means having a good report in the church and community.
  - The church's reputation in the community is often connected to the deacon's reputation in the community.
- 2. The Deacon's Sincerity (8) "Deacons likewise must be dignified, not double-tongued..."
  - Too often, the world sees the church as a bunch of hypocrites.
  - o To avoid being double tongued, one must have a humble heart.
  - Non-hypocrisy directly correlates with the witness to the world.
- **3. The Deacon's Sobriety (8)** "Deacons likewise must be dignified, not double-tongued, not addicted to much wine..."
  - Simple truth: don't drink alcohol.
  - o 1 Thess. 5:22, "abstain from the appearance of evil."
  - It is a biblical concept to surrender our temporary freedoms to advance the eternal causes of Christ.
- **4. The Deacon's Generosity (8)** "Deacons likewise must be dignified, not double-tongued, not addicted to much wine, not greedy for dishonest gain."
  - Greed is a human condition that has invaded our society.
  - Generosity is the antidote to a greedy mindset.
  - "It's amazing how, no matter where you keep it, your pocketbook is always in such close proximity to your heart."
- 5. **The Deacon's Conviction (9)** "They must hold the mystery of the faith with a clear conscience."
  - Our society is now post-Christian and there are many questions.
  - o A deacon does not have to be an expert, but he should be firm in his faith.
- **6. The Deacon's Experience (10)** "And let them also be tested first; then let them serve as deacons if they prove themselves blameless."
  - Deacons are often asked questions before ordination.
  - This passage is more about character than a checkbox.
  - Perseverance is the key character trait here for a deacon.

- 7. **The Deacon's Home (11-12)** "Their wives likewise must be dignified, not slanderers, but soberminded, faithful in all things. <sup>12</sup> Let deacons each be the husband of one wife, managing their children and their own households well."
  - The phrase "husband of one wife" means literally "one-woman man." The deacon must be a one-woman kind of man.
  - o This is also a test of character and includes how he manages his home life.
  - o This is not a harsh judgment on the wife and children.
- **8. The Deacon's Reward (13)** "For those who serve well as deacons gain a good standing for themselves and also great confidence in the faith that is in Christ Jesus."
  - o There is a two-fold reward here: good standing and good witness.
  - o One is internal to the church, the other external to the world!
  - o "A deacon stands tallest on his knees. He is most honorable when he is most humbled."
