

Kid's Ministry Evaluation Questions

Overall Kid's Ministry Vision:

- Why do we believe kids' ministry matters in the church?
- What is the main goal and vision of our kid's ministry?
- What impact do we hope to have on the kids we serve?
- How do we measure spiritual growth in the kids we serve?
- What are we doing well, and what needs improvement?
- Are our activities and lessons helping us achieve our goals?
- How connected is our kid's ministry to the overall church mission?
- How can we make sure our ministry reflects Jesus' love to every child?

Engaging Environments:

- What's one way we can make a child feel welcome on their first visit?
- Do the kids enjoy coming each week?
- Are the children developing friendships and relationships with leaders?
- Do kids feel safe, welcomed, and included?
- How can we support kids who come from difficult family situations?

Planning & Preparing:

- How do we keep kids engaged during a lesson?
- What creative methods can we use (games, crafts, stories, media) to teach the Bible effectively?
- How do we balance fun with spiritual depth?
- Are the lessons age-appropriate and engaging?
- Do the lessons build upon one another to create a lasting foundation?
- Do the children understand and remember what they are learning?
- Is our curriculum biblically sound and relevant?
- How often do we review or refresh our teaching materials?

Volunteers & Leadership:

- What strengths does our team bring to kids' ministry?
- How can we encourage and support each other as a volunteer team?
- Is the volunteer schedule sustainable and fair?
- Do leaders feel equipped and confident in their roles?
- Are we providing enough training, support, and appreciation?
- What areas do we need more training or development or encouragement in?

Safety & Policies:

- Are our check-in/out procedures safe and efficient?
- Is the classroom clean, organized and welcoming?
- Do we have enough supplies and resources each week?
- How should we handle a child who won't listen or disrupts class?
- Are volunteers trained in safety and emergency protocols?
- What is our plan if a child gets hurt or upset?
- How can we make sure every child feels safe and included?
- Do we comply with all child protection and background check policies?

Communication with Parents:

- How can we communicate with today's parents?
- How often do we communicate with parents about what their kids are learning?
- Do parents feel informed, supported, and involved?
- Are parents encouraged to continue faith conversations at home?
- How can we better partner with parents in their child's spiritual growth?

Spiritual Impact of Ministry:

- Are kids being given regular opportunities to pray, worship, and serve?
- Have we seen evidence of kids growing in faith or asking spiritual questions?
- How do we celebrate spiritual milestones (salvations, baptisms, etc.)?
- How can we create more moments that lead kids closer to Jesus?
